People who focus more on what God's revealed will for us in Scripture tend also to make wise decisions about all those other areas the Bible does not explicitly address.

# A BIBLICAL DECISION-MAKING FUNNEL


The Specific Issue: [you fill in the blank, whatever it is]

## 1. What are the PRIORITIES & PRINCIPLES from Scripture?

### • In your Godward relationships

→Who owns me? (Ps.100:3; Prov. 3:6; 1 Cor.6:19-20) / →What is His chief desire?—To be magnified, to see sinners saved (2 Pet.3; 1 Tim.2), and to see me grow in Christlikeness (Rom.8:29, etc.) / →So what will most glorify Him (1 Cor.10:31) and grow me? Am I just seeking what is most comfortable, or what will make me most Christlike? / →Is this specifically identified as a sin in Scripture? (Ps.119:9,11, etc.) / →Can I do this in full faith, with a clear conscience? (Rom.14:23; the "holding principle") / →Would I be embarrassed if a spiritual leader saw me doing it? If so, does that reveal that I wouldn't want God seeing me do it? (Prov.5:21; Heb.4:13) / →Will I regret this decision when I stand before Christ at the judgment seat? (2 Cor.5:9-10; 1 Jn.2:28) / →Do I have an eternal mindset, remembering how temporal this life is? (Php.3:20; Col.3:1-2)



The Decision:

<u>The Determination</u>—To move ahead with a clear conscience, not worrying, but trusting in a sovereign, all-wise, good and gracious God who is working out His perfect will for my good and His glory!
